

Research Materials. – 1933-1997; predominant 1967-1986. – 1.3 m of textual records. – Title based on content of series. Files contain bibliographical notes, newspaper and magazine clippings, articles and are arranged alphabetically by file title, quotation marks indicating the title of the original file. Arrangement was imposed by the archivist as the files came in no discernable order and most without dates. Researchers should also consult Series 1: Writing as some titles are identical between these series.
